

Friends-in-Need (FINs) at Redhill



Thanks to the monthly Second Collection for the Poor in our parish, we provide cash assistance to over 140 people (called “Friends-in-Need”), many of whom are elderly, sick or disabled staying in one-room HDB rental flats at Blocks 89 and 90 Redhill Close.

Besides being financially poor, many of the FINs struggle with other problems such as poor health, loneliness & strained family ties. SSVP members befriend them, pray for them and assist them by connecting them to the relevant government aid, social service or voluntary welfare organisations. SSVP members visit the FINs regularly offering a listening ear to their problems and providing assistance (where possible).
