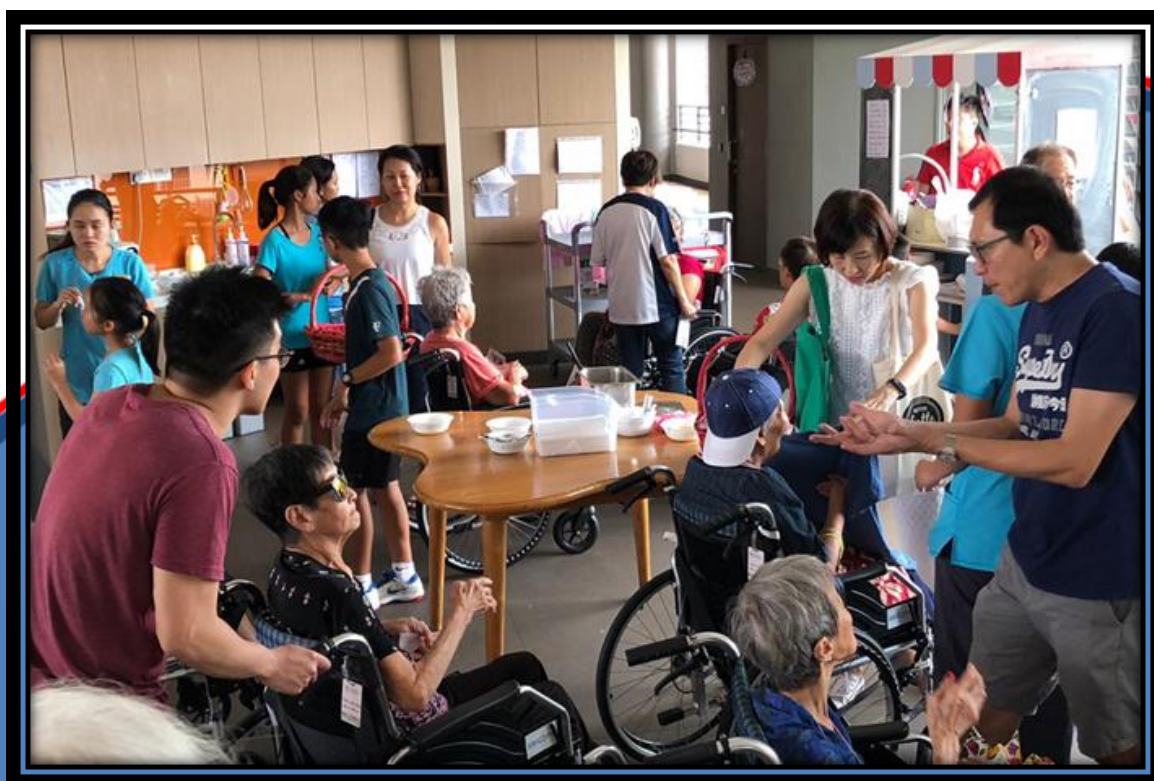


# Goin-a-Shoppin Project at St Joseph Home
