God's Kingdom has presence among us, in the person of Jesus Christ, but not yet reached to fullness. This weekend, we celebrate the ultimate journey of our faith, the solemnity Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. It is also the end of the Ordinary Time, as we move into the Advent call to prepare ourselves for the coming King, Emmanuel, God-is-with-us. The readings describe the rich images of Christ Jesus, the God-with-us. He is the Good Shepherd, who will look after us; the First-fruits of the harvest that describes the faithful's relationship between Christ's resurrection and the resurrection of the dead; the Son of Man, the just-judge, who sees all things and cares for those who hunger and thirst, welcoming the strangers and lost. Christ Jesus, the Eternal King, tells us that when we see and respond to anyone in need, we are also seeing and responding to Him, the God-with-us.

On the World Day of the Poor last weekend, Pope Francis reminded us, "The Kingship of Christ is most evident on Golgotha ... incarnates and reveals the fullness of God's love. Jesus' complete abandonment to the Father expresses his utter poverty and reveals the power of the Love that awakens him to new life on the day of the Resurrection."

rayer is an act of communication that allows us to talk to God. We, the Sojourners' Companions, are prayer guides who strive to help anyone learn how to pray the Ignatian way using the scriptures. When we pray we are drawn closer to God, and it is in the scriptures that God reveals Himself to us.

All that is required of you, if you sign up for the Week of Guided Prayer, is a commitment to spend 30 minutes each day praying with a suggested scripture passage, and another 30 minutes meeting your prayer guide at a pre-arranged time on a one-on-one basis. The Week starts with a Taster Afternoon (2pm – 5pm) this Sunday, 26 November. It closes with a group session (2pm – 5pm) on Saturday, 2 December.

How can I adequately put down in words what I experienced during the six days that I decided even at this later stage of my life to spend time with Jesus. I have always yearned to feel, really feel the love of God in my life. There was, however, a small part of me that resisted going deeper, that even feared to go deeper into prayer time with our Lord. Afraid that I would be asked to tread treacherous waters, to go where I know I will sink. I can only say that it was the power of the Holy Spirit that worked in my being so that I was able to gather the courage and discipline to enter into Ignation contemplation and Lectio

Divina in an attempt to encounter Jesus.

The result was mind-blowing and

heart bursting. There were times when I found I couldn't identify with anything in the scripture passage, but I persisted in just continuing to talk with Jesus; and at times just not think or say anything, but just to stay in the passage. I wanted very much to feel Jesus with me. It was hard. I believed he was present, but I was not feeling it in full reality. Gradually as I stopped trying too hard and decided to be comfortable and still, I began to feel this huge wave of God's love entering my heart at certain points of the passages.

I cannot begin to describe the depth of this love that I felt, but I know that I felt it and that Jesus is indeed present and alive, and living and moving with me. He is telling me that this is only the beginning and promises me that there is more love in store for me. And it's going to be this love that will move me to do what He wants me to do and be who He wants me to be. My task now is, weak as I am, to pray to remain strong in faith and to set aside time to spend with the one who loves me most in all the world.
